

Suggested Assessment Areas to Determine Evidence of GANG-RELATED ACTIVITY

1. Evidence of graffiti in the neighborhoods.
2. Evidence of crossed-out graffiti in neighborhoods.
3. Evidence of students wearing varied colors of clothing or flashing hand signals.
4. Evidence of drugs available at or near schools.
5. Evidence of physical confrontations & intimidations in or around schools.
6. Evidence of increase in weapons in the community to include schools.
7. Evidence of pagers or cell phones being used by students in schools.
8. Evidence of drive-by shootings in or around various neighborhoods.
9. Evidence of weapons being displayed in and around schools.
10. Increase in truancy/drop-out rate.
11. Evidence of increase of racial incidents in the community to include schools.
12. Evidence of history of gang-related incidents in community to include schools.
13. Increase in presence of informal social groups.
